



Professor Richard Sikora, Head, Soil Ecosystem Phytopathology Section at the University of Bonn, Germany. Born in Norfolk, USA, Richard received his M.Sc. PhD at the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana in 1970. He is the recipient of numerous honors, including: Fellow of the Society of Nematologists; Award of Merit University of Illinois Alumni Association; Fellow of the European Society of Nematology; J. Van den Brande Award for International Plant Protection, University of Gent, Belgium; Hackett Fellow in Plant Pathology, U.S. Department of Agriculture; Sigma Xi Honorary Research Society, German Industrial Award for Plant Protection. He has trained more than 150 students and post-doctoral scientists in research on ecology, nematology, plant pathology and biological control. Richard has edited five scientific books and written two handbooks for students, 22 invited chapters in books, over 162 scientific papers published with 100 in peer reviewed journals, and has three patents.
